## 4. Typefaces in Microsoft Office

The Maj typeface is style linked to work with shortcuts in Microsoft Office. Microsoft Office applications like Word use shortcuts for switching between the different weights of a typeface, e.g. make the type bold = choosing the bold weight by pressing 'ctrl+B'(Windows) / 'cmd+B'(Mac OS) (Danish shortcut: ctrl+F). Style-linking can include 4 weights, typically, but not limited to: Regular, Regular Italic, Bold and Bold Italic. This is why Maj typeface, in some versions of Microsoft Office, appears as 'Maj' (contains both Regular and Bold) and 'Maj Light' in the font menu. This is not an error, but simply the way Microsoft Office handles typefaces – by collapsing only linked weights into one.

## 5. OpenType features

The Maj typeface comes with the following OpenType features:

- Tabular numbers
  - Contextual alternates for uppercase hyphen, endash and emdash.
  - Fractions

The Maj typeface contains the Latin-1 character set and supports the following languages:

Complete coverage:

Afrikaans, Albanian, Basque, Breton, Corsican, Danish, English, Faroese, Galician, German, Icelandic, Irish, Indonesian, Italian, Kurdish, Leonese, Luxembourgish, Malay, Manx, Norwegian, Occitan, Portuguese, Rhaeto-Romanic, Scottish Gaelic, Spanish, Swahili, Swedish, Walloon


Basic, but incomplete coverage:
